HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE PROGRAM PRIVATIZES PAINT SALES

As of **July 1, 2015**, the City of Tucson's Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) paint sales will be at Gerson's Building Materials, 4726 S. Country Club Road, and the Beacon Group will manage the sales. The HHW program **will continue to collect paint** at its sites and outreach collection events. "This will provide a substantial savings in our operating costs, yet continue to provide a sales outlet for the public," said Andrew H. Quigley, director of Environmental Services. Latex paint collected by the program is not hazardous and easily can be processed by a subcontractor.

VACATION SAFETY TIPS FROM TUCSON POLICE

Vacations are supposed to be a time to leave troubles behind, but criminals can put a damper on your time away. The Tucson Police Department (TPD) offers some tips to keep you safe while you're away. Those tips include telling your trustworthy neighbors when you'll be away so they can look after your house, never carrying large amounts of cash, carrying only the credit cards you plan to use, not leaving valuables in your hotel room, and more.

JOB OPPORTUNITY: POLICE

DISPATCHER - The Tucson Police Department (TPD) currently has multiple vacancies for Public Safety Dispatcher within the Communications Division. The position involves skilled radio communications, including dispatching emergency and non-emergency calls for service. The position requires the dispatcher to relay critical information via a radio system to public safety personnel who are dispatched for service. The dispatcher also evaluates, triages, disseminates information, and keeps track of the location and welfare of the responders. The job also requires the dispatcher to access and enter computer information according to established policies and procedures. Extensive keyboarding and multitasking abilities are essential.
