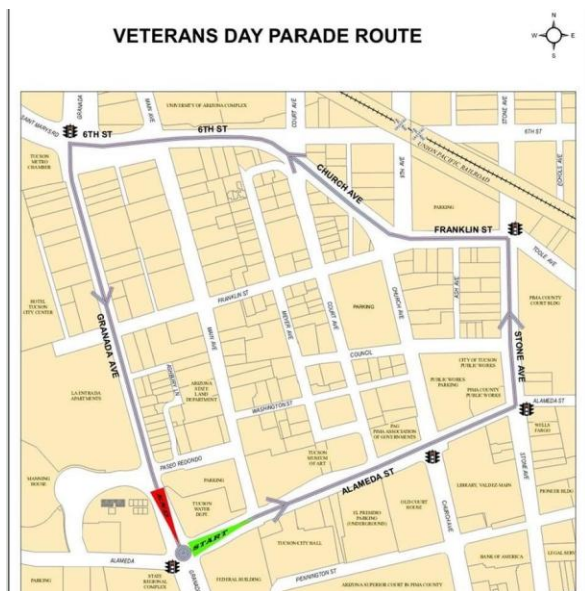

The 97th annual **Tucson Veterans Day Parade** is set for **Friday, Nov. 11, at 11 a.m.**

The parade's theme this year is "Remembering Pearl Harbor: 75 Years Later." Participants will start assembling downtown around 8 a.m., and traffic restrictions will be in place throughout the day. The parade begins at the corner of **Alameda Street & Granada Avenue**,

travels through parts of the downtown area, and returns to the staging point on Alameda.

Downtown businesses, parking garages, and parking lots will be open and accessible. Parking will be free at meters and in the City/State Garage at 498 W. Congress St.

## The Community Justice Boards

(CJB) is a diversion program for youth ages 8-17 who have committed a first or second time minor offense. It is a unique, non-punitive alternative to the traditional justice model. Community members are trained to serve on volunteer justice boards to work with youth to help them understand the impact of their actions. The youth's progress is monitored over a 90 day period by the CJB as they empower them to make better choices today with a focus on their future.

The Pima County Attorney's Office currently is looking for volunteers to serve on the Southside Community Justice Board. The meetings take place in the evening, twice a month. For those interested in more involvement, we have volunteer leadership positions available. ## Safe Routes to School Grant has come to Reality for Liberty Bike Blvd.

There was a meeting regarding the Liberty Bike Blvd which will begin in the summer/fall of 2018. It will be from 43<sup>rd</sup> Ave to Los Reales. It will be coming down Liberty crossing over to San Fernando, a quick hop to Fiesta and crossing back to San Fernando over Valencia to Los Reales.

- There will also be the new pedestrian signalized (HAWK) crossing at 12<sup>th</sup> Ave. and Canada St.
- Sidewalk and ADA ramp improvements on Nebraska St. and Liberty.
- Upgrading existing pedestrian crossings to facilitate bicycle

crossing at Valencia, Irvington and Ajo.

- There will also be the creation of traffic calming devices and traffic controls along the 4.85 section of Liberty and San Fernando Avenues.

The project is expected to take 6 months.

The City of Tucson is also initiating a planning study for 12<sup>th</sup> Ave from 40<sup>th</sup> St. to Drexel Rd. The purpose of the study is to identify improvements to the safety and comfort of people walking, bicycling, using transit, and driving in the corridor, so funding can be obtained to make final recommendations a reality.
